Forest Hill and Tiger Conservation

A spectacular new 5-acre forest habitat for endangered Sumatran Tigers opened at the San Diego Zoo's Safari Park over Memorial Day weekend. Several dozen Forest Hill neighbors generously supported the funding effort. We are now enshrined prominently on a donor plaque at the entrance plaza.

The forest has three big enclosures with up-close viewing for the public and rocks, logs, water, trees and plenty of open space for the animals to explore. Sadly, the five new residents total about one percent of all living Sumatran Tigers. The species is highly endangered due to poaching and habitat loss. Part of the funds raised will go toward tiger field research on their native island of Sumatra.

The Safari Park (not the San Diego Zoo) is located in the San Pasqual Valley 35 miles northeast of downtown San Diego. Interesting Clubhouse **Rental Facts**

Did you know?

- Of the 50 contracts closed in 2014 68% are to FHA members.
- October, March and June are the most popular rented months at the Clubhouse.
- 3. An average event at the Clubhouse costs \$450-\$550 to the FHA.
- 50% of events at the clubhouse are sponsored by an FHA member to a non-FHA member.

Summer pruning of the deciduous trees (those that lose their leaves) that are the responsibility of the FHA will begin on or around August 25th. The FHA is only responsible for pruning trees in the sidewalk or median strips. As we have done for the last few years, we will post the proposed trees to be pruned on our website (http://www.foresthill-sf.com/ association/FHA-treeCare.html) August 18th for your review and comments until August 25th. If you have a request for additional pruning, please email Diane Wara at warad@peds.ucsf.edu and include your tree's number (on the trunk within 5' of the ground) and your address. We will review all requests made between August 18 and August 25 and, when adding to our budgeted pruning will consider whether the tree has been pruned during the last three years. Kyle Sager (Valley Crest) and I will review all requests for tree pruning in addition to that posted. Please remember that we prune trees on a 3 year cycle, unless a tree has had an unusual growth pattern and requires earlier pruning. Our pines and cyprus will be pruned during late January because summer pruning may actually damage the trees. Please understand that we never "top" trees and that we do not shape trees but, rather, remove excess foliage that will allow a tree to remain healthy and thus have a longer life span.

We are aware that the trees throughout Forest Hill are aging and that an increasing number will require removal for safety reasons during the next few years. We're developing a list of trees that likely will require removal and will work with homeowners to identify appropriate replacement trees. Finally, newly planted trees require frequent watering. Because of our ongoing drought, we have elected to not plant any replacement trees until there is evidence that the skies have opened in response to the rain gods. All replacements will be deferred until at least November, 2014. Thank you for your understanding.
